Drain Care:

- Keep skin around drain clean and dry.
 - Keep a daily record of the output from your drain in “cc” or “mL” amounts. Note: you may need to empty your drain multiple times per day.
 - DO NOT IRRIGATE.
 - Drain site care / Dressing changes / Use of Biopatch (if applicable) as per instructed by your physician:
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- Watch for signs of possible infection which include redness, swelling, heat, red streaks and / or elevated temperature above 100.5°F consistently. Note: fevers can be normal for first 3-4 days post-operative
- Watch for problems such as:
 - a. Blockage of the drain – if this happens, continue to “strip” drain
 - b. Swelling around the drain site and / or leaking around the drain site
 - c. Drain becomes dislodged or broken
 - d. Stitches become loose or broken
 - e. There is blood in or around your catheter (You may or may not have a small amount of oozing after the drain placement that should not last more than 24-48 hours.)
- Contact your physician if any of these or other problems occur.
